Felix charges \$149 a month.
The pen is \$88. *We subtracted.*

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Felix doesn't publish the split. "Everything else" is our arithmetic: their price minus Costco's. It doubles when your dose does, because the medication is where the margin lives.

A bundled price hides the care fee inside the medication. Ask for the split. If they won't give it, that is the answer.

TeleTest is \$49. If you only need a prescription, go there. *We mean it.*

FELIX MINUS BASAL, AT 2 MG	\$1,116
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Yes, TeleTest is cheaper. The \$152 a year buys
twelve monthly dose reviews and someone to message.
If you don't want that, don't buy it.

Ask for *the receipt*.

- 01 What does the pen cost at Costco, and what do you charge on top?
- 02 Can I fill it at a pharmacy I choose?
- 03 Does your price go up when my dose does?
- 04 Am I charged if you decide not to prescribe?
- 05 Does a pharmacy pay you anything?

OUR ANSWERS

- 01 · the pen, plus us \$88 + \$29
- 02 · your pharmacy yes
- 03 · price rises with dose no
- 04 · charged if not prescribed no
- 05 · money from a pharmacy \$0.00
